CONFIRMATION CLASSES AT
ST. PAUL'S UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST

Confirmation at St. Paul's is a rite of the church which confers one's own responsibility for the affirmation of faith. Confirmation has been an important rite of the church since its founding in 1886. The particular steps that confirmands take have changed throughout the years, but not the significance of this personal witness to our faith in Christ.

Following a lengthy period of study, each of the confirmands has been asked to give some kind of public presentation. In the early history of the church, confirmands were asked to answer questions from the catechism. In recent history, confirmands were asked to make a sermon that offers the truth of faith as they experience that truth in their own lives. All classes have made witness before the entire church.

The rite of confirmation is centered on two promises, which each individual must make for themselves:

"Do you confess your faith in Christ as Lord and Savior?
I confess my faith.

Do you promise, according to the grace given you,
always to remain a faithful member of the church
of our Lord Jesus Christ, to come to the Lord's table,
to love and serve God in the world, bearing witness
to the risen Lord?
I promise."

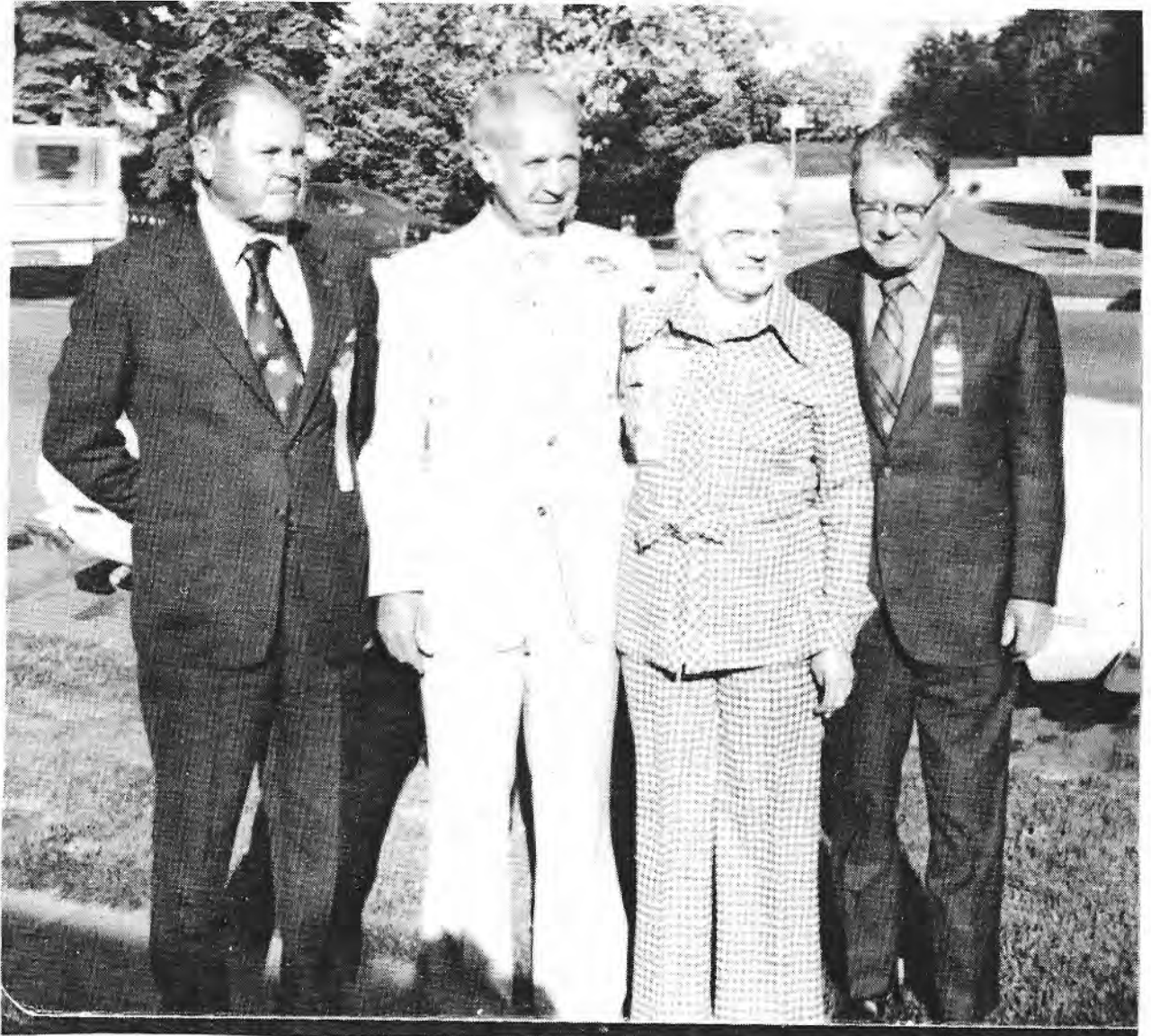

1986 LIVING CONFIRMANDS FROM FIRST 40 YEARS:

MELCHER, Mamie-Salter- was born in Laramie December 24, 1890. Her parents were August Melcher and Augusta Niethe, the second wedding performed in St. Paul's Church in 1887. Her brother Otto and sister Elizabeth O'Connor are deceased; her brothers Albert and ~~Harold are living.~~

Mamie was married to Harry Salter, railroad engineer, and has one daughter, ~~June Weir, living~~ in Casper where Mamie has been in a nursing home for a number of years. Her granddaughter Sharon Moffat-Johnson lives in Denver.

Mamie was active in the Frauen Verein and is also remembered as an outstanding singer in the choir. She was confirmed in 1904. by Rev. Adolph Walton. died 11/89

METZLER, Karl Wilhelm was born December 9, 1893 in Laramie, and was confirmed in 1907 by Rev. Adolph Walton, and is the oldest living confirmand in Laramie.

His parents were Richard and Marie Nee Niethe. 'Bill' went to work at an early age at the U.P. Rolling Mills. Later he was a Machinist at the R.R. shops until he retired in 1958.

He married Bertha Koehler in Omaha, Nebraska in 1915. He had two sons, William Jr. and Robert, and a daughter Eleanor Boyd Kivisto. All three children, his wife, and grandson are deceased. He has 5 grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren and one great, great granddaughter.

Bill served as a church Trustee and helped with repairs and chores. His wife, Bertha, was a good singer and loved to sing Stille Nacht in German. His daughter-in-law Ruth has been the diligent worker on the church history and records. His granddaughter Cheryl Green has been a Youth sponsor and Trustee. There are 7 Metzler Confirmants.

Bill lives at the Louise Swain Senior Housing and still is active except for limited hearing and eyesight, at age 92. died 8/87

WICHMANN, Arthur was born in 1896 and confirmed in 1910. He was the son of Rev. O.G. Wichmann who was pastor of St. Pauls 1908 to 1918, and the first family to live in the parsonage. The mother died, and Aunt Martha lived with them until she had to leave Laramie due to altitude problems.

Arthur graduated from UW. He spent many years in South America as a mining engineer, and later years was in Golden School of Mines as an instructor, where he retired. He had two sons, his wife died, and Arthur is now living in Wester Hills Home in Lakewood died 10/86

SPIEGELBERG, Anna was born in Larmie in December 1899 and confirmed in 1913. Her parents were Franz L. and Lisetta Zernikow who were married in St. Paul's Church Feb. 8, 1890. Her deceased siblings were Elsie Noah, Antonie Cornelius, Franz Walter, Willie Ludwig and Selma Erickson.

In 1932 she joined her brothers Walter and William and young brother George in the Spiegelberg Lumber Co. as head bookkeeper.

Anna was the gracious donor of a Hammond Organ and the 21-bell Carillon for St. Paul's Church as well as numerous other gifts. At the age of 86 she still lives in her parents' home at 154 N. Hodgeman near the Spiegelberg Lumber Co. on the West Side of Laramie where a number of the early members of the church had their homes. Her devoted family enjoy visiting with her to hear her reminisces. Although unable to attend church very often she is a staunch supporter of the church. died 1988

WICHMANN, Hildegard was born in 1900, confirmed in 1914 and graduated from UW. She was a teacher in Portland before she retired and moved to San Diego where she is still very active in church and community work. She travels quite often on tours and to visit relatives. She plans to be in Laramie for the Centennial celebration. Her nephew, Capt. Richard Day, USN Chaplain, will be the speaker for the worship services June 29.

MELCHER, Albert was born in Laramie August 24, 1900 and confirmed in 1915. At age 16 he worked as a railroad Crew-caller (12 hours, 7 days a week for \$50 a month) Then he worked as a train Yard Clerk until he became a machinist.

He married Bertha Osterman in 1922 and joined the Trinity Lutheran Church. They had three sons, Albert, William, and Robert living in Laramie; and daughters Jeanette Graham in Berkeley, California and Isabel Reitz in Albuquerque N.M.

He retired in 1960 on a disability after the RR shops were closed in Laramie. His wife died in 1974. He enjoys fishing, dancing, and life in general at age 86. One remembrance he had of Confirmation was that if they had problems answering questions, they would say "o Gee" and Rev. Wichmann would say "that's my name".

Harold Melcher was born January 25, 1904 in Laramie. He is Mamie and Albert's brother. Harold was confirmed in 1918 in the last class of Rev. Wichmann with George Spiegelberg and Louise Hunziker Messer and all three of them have been faithful workers in the church, including his wife Dixie.

Harold was employed by Spiegelberg Lumber Co. In 1972 he and some volunteers remodeled the pastor's study and enclosed the furnace; Gus Erickson painted the basement, in a short time, in preparation for the Wyoming Association meeting here.

Harold and Dixie moved to California, when he retired, to be near their daughter, Bobette Danneltell. They came annually to visit and remained members. Dixie died in 1985. Harold is living with Bobette and is in poor health. died 8/86

George F. Spiegelberg was born March 21, 1903 in Laramie and was confirmed in 1918 in Rev. Wichmann's last class. His parents were Franz L. and Lisetta Zernikow. His father was one of the charter members of the Deutsche Evangelische Lutherische Kirche in 1886.

George has been a faithful worker and officer in the church all of his life. Since the building of the Springbrook Apartments he has been on the Properties Board and served as Chairman of it. George and his brothers, Walter and William founded the Spiegelberg Lumber Company in 1932 and his sister Anna also joined the company as head bookkeeper.

George was married to Helen McKittrick and their two children, Martha (Millard) Johnson and John, were baptized and confirmed and became active members of the church. Also Martha's daughters, Julie and Beth are confirmands of St. Paul's. George retired from the company in 1968 but remains active and interested in the church.

Louise Hunziker Messer was born in Laramie September 15, 1905 and was confirmed in 1918 in the last class of Rev. Wichmann and has stayed in St. Paul's as a faithful worker. Her parents were members of the church but she is the only one of her siblings in St. Paul's.

Louise was a telephone operator and married Philip Messer in 1924 and continued working for several years. Later she spent many hours doing quilting for church projects in the basement and continues as a faithful member of the Women's Fellowship.

Their daughter Phyllis was confirmed in 1944 and left Laramie when she married Malcolm Cook and has lived in Cheyenne. They have two son, Norman living in California, and Mike, living in Iowa.

Frederick Wahl was born September 29, 1905 in Dalark, Arkansas and was confirmed in 1920 by Rev. William Schmidt in a class of 10 members, all deceased. His parents, William and Anna Wahl came to Laramie in 1907 when they had a job at the John F. Fischer ranch, and became members of St. Paul's.

Fred was a R.R. Crew-caller and became a RR Machinist. In 1928 he became a pilot and started the first airplane school and airline in Laramie. Later he was a Captain for Western Airlines in Los Angeles for 28 years, and retired in 1965. At 80 years of age now he still flies his own plane and grows KIWI's etc. on a small farm in Lindsay, California. His son, Allen, lives in San Jose, California, and daughter Claova Johnston lives in Tacoma, Washington. Fred and wife Margaret will attend the Anniversary celebration.

Helen Svenson Wickam was born in Laramie and confirmed in 1921 by Rev. O.F. Geisler. After graduation from UW she taught school in Wyoming communities and married Joe Wickam. They returned to Laramie after their retirement. She now lives at Iverson Home and has a son Joe Wickam living in Laramie.

Helen's father, Henning Svenson, was President of St. Paul's several years and photographed many Confirmand groups when he owned the Svenson Studio which later became Ludwig Studio; Lottie Svenson married 'Doc' Ludwig.

Helen's sisters, Anneleas Boyden and Lottie Ludwig (confirmands of 1924 and 1927) are deceased. Her niece, Carol Ludwig Loyer (1954 confirmand) lives in Cheyenne and manages Ludwig Studios there and in Laramie.

Alma Roeseler-Crass was born in Laramie and was confirmed in 1921. She moved to Denver when she married and is living with a relative at present.

Stella Moede-Spauling was born August 6, 1903 at Red Cloud, Nebraska. She came to Laramie in September 1921 to work at the Home Bakery. She was confirmed December 1922 with her uncle, George Topham, as adults by Rev. Geisler.

She married Oran (Bud) Spaulding June 23, 1923. he died in November 1972. Her children: J. Elwood Spaulding was confirmed in 1940 and served in the Airforce over 30 years, now is retired and working in Washington D.C.

Eleanor Workman was confirmed in 1944 and graduated as a Dental Assistant in California, now is living in Laramie and working for the National Forest Service. Two daughters, Jill Knight and Janice Cozad live in Laramie. Janice is a member of St. Paul's. Eleanor is presently a diligent worker as a member of the Diaconate.

Stella Schwass-Thompson was born in Ft. Collins and was confirmed in 1923 by Rev. Geisler when she was a student at the University of Wyoming. She taught school in the Torrington area after her husband died and lives in Torrington now. died 1990

Walter Wahl was born in Laramie September 6, 1908 and was confirmed in 1923. He was a RR Machinist until he lost his wife, Elvira Murdock, in 1945. He remarried and was a lathe machinist for Dow Chemical at Rocky Flats, Colorado until he retired in 1973 and moved to Ft. Collins.

His two sons, William and Walter were confirmed in St. Paul's. William is an MD in Cheyenne and Walter lives in Long Beach, California.

Emma Wahl Rice was born in Laramie in 1910 and confirmed in 1924 by Rev. Geisler. This class of 7 girls became the HAPPY THOUGHT CIRCLE and later were in the YOUNG PEOPLE'S LEAGUE that made candy to sell for funds to buy the two stained glass windows in the rear of the church and vestibule. Emma taught Sunday School and played the organ until she graduated from college and went teaching. In 1934 she married William Rice from Meeteetse. Their wedding in 1934 was the first church ceremony that Rev. Robert Young performed as an ordained minister.

They lived in several places in Wyoming before returning to Laramie in 1941 with their three children and Bill became a RR Fireman for 'war work' and retired in 1973. He was the "fix-it" man at church as well as holding all offices. He died in 1983. Their children, Wallace, Janice and Richard are all confirmands.

Three other living members of this class are: Dorothea Pregal Ankeny in Belen NM; Maxine Weick Doughty in Spokane; Helen Trautewig Scoggan in Scottsbluff;

The class of 1927 confirmed by Rev. August Doellefeld had 11 members, with 4 deceased.

Henry Huetting Schroeder was employed at the Laramie Post Office until his retirement, when he spends winters in Arizona.

Ernest Fingerlos was employed at Laramie Boomerang until he moved to California. He plans to attend the Confirmand and Wurl family reunion.

Richard Wahl became an Examiner in the U.S. Patent Office and retired as Asst. Commissioner in 1974 and moved to St. Petersburg FL. He plans to attend the celebration.

John Buchholz graduated from UW in Engineering and lives in Los Banos CA.

Eugene Doellefeld has lived in the St. Louis area since his parents left Laramie. died '87

Margaret Koch-McGregor was in the WACs, married and lives in New Jersey.

Evangeline Zinn-Vivian taught school, married and lives in Grand Junction. Graveside services were held May 29 for her mother Elizabeth Zinn, 97 years old.

THE SPIEGELBERG FAMILY

Frank L. Spiegelberg and his wife, Lisetta Zernikow, were Charter Members of St. Paulus Deutsche Evāngelische Lutherische Kirche in 1886.

Since his descendants were all involved in the Spiegelberg Lumber Company, they had contributed generously to the building and care of the property, as well as serving as officers throughout the past 100 years.

Most of their children are Confirmands:

Elsie (A.B.Noah) in 1897; Antonia (Cornelius) was one of the first babies baptized in 1886, and she was confirmed in 1900; Selma (Oscar Erickson) in 1905; Walter and William in 1907.

Two surviving children are Anna confirmed in 1913, and George F. in 1918.

Other living descendants include:

Walter's son George W.; William's sons Frank and James; and George F.s daughter Martha (Millard) Johnson ; and son John.

Frank's son Gary; Jim's sons William II, Emory and Joe; and George W.s son Steven; Martha's daughters Julie and Beth; Steven's sons Ronald and Eric.

Gary's son Frank; his daughter Brenda (Dwight Arnold) is starting a sixth generation with a baby daughter, Hope.

Hopefully the younger generations will continue to carry on the work of St. Paul's United Church of Christ during the next 100 years.

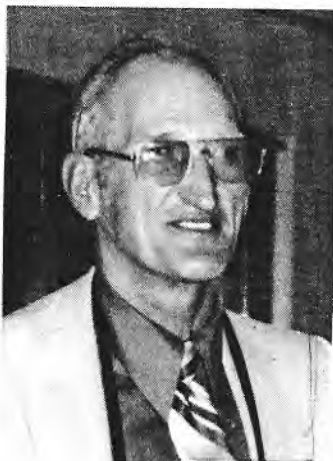
